- 4. What is the context of this passage? What has Jesus been talking about, which helps us to better understand his words here?
- 5. Why do people often go to one of two extremes, either at Boiling Point (always ready to retaliate) or as a Helpless Victim (spineless doormat)? What is the middle look like that Jesus calls us to here?
- 6. Why is it so important that we extend kindness and love outside our small circle of close connections?

DIGGING DEEPER (EXTRA CREDIT!)

- 7. How can't his passage be used to justify or enable abuse or theft. How can we use this passage without doing that?
- 8. Jesus calls us to "perfect love." What does he mean, since we are far from perfect.
